3. Forwarding Personal Information

Controller may forward Personal Information to the following third parties:

4. Data subject rights

You have the right:

• pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR, to demand information about your Personal Information that we have processed. In particular, you can obtain information about the purposes of the processing, The categories of Personal Information concerned, the recipients or category of recipients to whom you data have been or will be disclosed, the envisaged period for which

the data will be stored, the existence of the right to request rectification, erasure, or restriction of the processing, or to object to it, the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, the source of your data, if these have not been collected by us, and on the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and any other meaningful information about their details or the logic involved;

- pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR, to demand the immediate rectification or completion of inaccurate Personal Information stored by us;
- pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR, to demand the erasure of Personal Information stored by us, unless their processing is necessary for exercising the right of freedom of expression and information, for compliance with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest, or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims;
- pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR, to demand the restriction of the processing of your Personal Information in cases where you contest the accuracy of the data, where the processing is unlawful yet you oppose the erasure of the Personal Information, where we no longer need the data but you still require them to establish, exercise or defend legal claims, or where you have objected to the processing of the data pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR;

5. Right of objection

Insofar as your Personal Information is processed on the basis of legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR, you have the right, under Art. 21 GDPR, to object to the processing of your Personal Information, provided there are reasons relating to your particular situation or if the objection relates to direct marketing. In the latter case, you have a general right to object, which shall be implemented by the Controller without any reference to a particular situation.
